- 6) Joe Person noted that 73% of Southfield residents voted for a ballot initiative to reinstate primary elections as provided prior to 2015.
- 7) Laren Baker introduced herself. She is a disability network specialist advocating for services in Oakland.
- 8) Kelly Breen thanked the OCDP for helping to flip the 38th State House seat from red to blue. She especially thanked the South Lyon Dem club members for their work.
- 9) Charlie Cavell thanked everyone for their support and is looking ahead to build for 2022.
- 10) John Freeman thanked Vaughn for his leadership. He said that getting people elected is part 1; part 2 is to enact legislation.
- 11) Rosemerry Allen stated that she is happy that turned Michigan blue.
- 12) Ravi Krishnaswami introduced himself. He is a member of the Troy Dem club.
